He removes his sunglasses, revealing another pair of sunglasses.

NEAL (CONT'D)

A place where hopes and dreams, nightmares and nirvanas are a reality. The world of tomorrow makes your world look like a bitch. Who among you will bravely step past the horizon of today into the future. I need a volunteer I've never seen before.

PHIL

I'm interested in the world of tomorrow!

Another swooshing noise. Tony enters playing PHIL, he also wears a variation of Mondy's dress pants, shirt and tie. He wears horn-rimmed glasses and carries a glass (or carton?) of milk and a newspaper.

PHIL (CONT'D)

What is this place?

NEAL

Welcome volunteer stranger from the audience. Stand in awe at the future!

PHIL

My milk's gone bad!

NEAL

Inhale the passage of time!

PHIL

Tomorrow's newspaper!

(CONTINUED)

CONTINUED:

NEAL

Behold March 13th!

PHIL

I've grown hair in my ears!

NEAL

As only you could in the place where  
what's next...is now!

PHIL

But the world of the future has to be  
more than just the day after tomorrow's  
yesterday!

NEAL

Huh? Oh! The day after tomorrows--yes!  
Yes, so much, much more than what you  
just said.

PHIL

Wow, the world of tomorrow seems filled  
with wonder and potential. What  
potentially wonderful things are possible  
in the future?

NEAL

How about X-ray mailboxes?

PHIL

Food pills?

NEAL

Self-combing hair?

PHIL

Cordless boat motors?

NEAL
